Yvonne - One lesson I was faced with the challenge of wrong times and resources due to teacher absence. BUT after reading the Bible, 2 boys produced a cross with a crown of thorns around it. "This symbolises the beauty and the suffering of Easter." Wow!

Carol - It's been great to work alongside so many church leaders encouraging them to host 8 classes. I was quite amazed at the number of Yr6 pupils who'd never been to a church before - this was between one third and one half! "The children said how educational the visit was, especially those that have never been inside a Church before. They had a fantastic time" (Year 6 Teacher, Tollgate)

Alice - Our 'Every Church for Every Child' project is on target—with 4 schools handed over to church workers to visit with support. We are on track to double our active church partners from 23 to 46 by the end of this academic year. 'Faith in Schools have helped us to grow our relationship with the school

closest to our church. We have enjoyed going in and teaching RE. Faith in Schools have help us get that relationship off the ground, to sustain it and given us wonderful resources and training so we feel really equipped to teach' (Crossway St Matthews Church)



Gillian - This term I delivered lessons with a majority evaluated as 6 (out of 6). I had excellent feedback from the teachers, especially Portway Primary (who have not had regular RE visitors before}. When I realised that I was telling 90 pupils about Jesus's resurrection today, it was just amazing!

EASTER EXPERIENCE 2023







From 13-24 March, 29 local primary schools and 40 churches gathered joyfully for the Easter Experience, a refreshing break from the gloomy economic forecast and sky high prices lately.

Hosted across 6 areas of the borough, these seasonal visits are **free**, **fun**, **and full of hope**.

2,310 pupils aged 8-9, along with their teachers and parent helpers, took part in 6 creative workshops which explore the story of Jesus' death and resurrection through performing and expressive arts.

We recruited and trained 83 volunteers who gave 742 hours to share why they celebrate Easter with Newham children.

Church leaders said: It's a great privilege to share our faith with those wonderful young minds and a real pleasure to be doing this together with the amazing team of Christians of all backgrounds and traditions."
